#### Minutes details:

#### I. Old Business:

- a. Discussion on boat launch dredging
  - i. Dredging permit we have 30 days until we can do the dredging- submitted April 14<sup>th</sup> so cannot perform until May 12<sup>th</sup> or later
    - 1. Need to give public chance to comment if no comments then will issue permit (DNR)
    - 2. May 13<sup>th</sup> soonest would want to see how quickly they would issue, would want to compete ASAP
    - 3. Will need to wait on boat ramp install until after dredging
      - a) Mark M- Set up Colin for May 18th (tentatively) assuming we have permit
      - b) Request formal quote from Colin with timeline etc. for tracking
  - ii. Keep in mind that will be a mess down there after dredge- plan to send an email warning residents as well as a note on the gate when it occurs. Joe has signs he can create for the gate
  - iii. How far do we go- are there restrictions on distance from launch?
    - 1. Suggest going as far as we can if we need to use the long reach equipment to go further into the channel then the cost will go up
      - a) Per DNR might be "just the washout" but a little unclear as to what this covers
    - 2. If use the long reach now, then can maintain for less in future
    - 3. Dean moves approval for up to \$12K, if the bid comes in at more then Joe to send email to board
      - a) Chris second
      - b) Unanimous approval
      - c) Motion approved
- b. Gravel- 4 loads of gravel to be added as well after the dredging to help clean up as well Colin can bring gravel as well may be most reasonable, specify limestone  $\frac{3}{4}$  (NOT crushed granite). Have Colin spread etc.
- c. New dock sections (4) to be added which will allow for fluctuations in the water level (will sit on the shore most of the time unless the water

- level goes up- then will not have a gap). Will still use the ramp at the end of the dock from shore
- d. Approval of meeting minutes from October 2021- Dean moves for approval, Chris second. Approved
- e. Financially- doing well even with the improvements. Have enough to cover the boat launch improvements. All dues paid except 3 people-Hittons (in Florida), Tim and Julie Davis- need to confirm that it was sold (Chad to look at CC website to confirm), Ray Williams- have been contacted  $2^{nd}/3^{rd}$  notices. Next step is small claims court.
  - i. Please keep Dean up to date on lots selling
